Please find listed below a consolidated summary of airline activity for December 2021.

There are six new airlines signed with Rich Content and Branding:

- **Royal Brunei Airlines (BI)** - is the flag carrier of Brunei Darussalam, based in Bandar Seri Begawan. It is wholly owned by the government of Brunei. Its hub is Brunei International Airport. Formed in 1974, Royal Brunei Airlines now operates to 32 destinations in Southeast Asia, the Middle East, Europe, and Oceania. Its fleet and type numbers increased dramatically in the 1990s.
- **Wind Rose Aviation (7W)** - legally *Wind Rose Aviation Company*, is a Ukrainian charter airline based at Boryspil International Airport. Founded in 2003, the airline's headquarters is in Kyiv; it operates charter flights to destinations in Europe, Turkey, Israel and Egypt.
- **Air Moldova (9U)** - is the national airline of Moldova, headquartered in Chişinău. It mainly operates scheduled and charter services to destinations within Europe.
- **Uzbekistan Airways (HY)** - is the flag carrier of Uzbekistan, headquartered in Tashkent. From its hub at Islam Karimov Tashkent International Airport, the airline serves a number of domestic destinations; the company also flies international services to Asia, Europe and North America.
- **Georgian Airways (A9)** - is the privately owned flag carrier of Georgia, with its main base at Tbilisi International Airport.

- **Aurigny (GR)** - is the flag carrier of Guernsey, its head office at Guernsey Airport in the Channel Islands, and wholly owned by the States of Guernsey since nationalization in 2003. It operates passenger and freight services between the Channel Islands and the United Kingdom (as well as seasonal services to Norwich and Grenoble).

There is one update to our FlexFlight participants;

- **Aviair (GD)** - previously known as **Slingair Heliwork**, is an airline and air charter company based in Kununurra, Western Australia. Its main bases are Kununurra Airport, Broome International Airport and Karratha Airport.

Our total of **live airlines is now at 315** with a further 27 airlines to go live, **so 342 contracted.**

We now have **89 signed of our Top 100 airlines with 86 live**; the three airlines waiting to go live are **All Nippon / ANA (NH)**, **Biman Bangladesh Airlines (BG)**, and **Turkish Airlines (TK)**

In other Ancillary news;

- **Georgian Airways (A9)** – migrated from SITA to Sirena-Travel (1H), they continue to support direct access, direct sell, electronic ticketing on Travelport+, they no longer support CBR. Migrated PNRs display a new record locator following the completion of the migration. Apollo and Worldspan participation were restricted with this migration, Agents need to contact the carrier directly for support with 1P or 1V active bookings
- **ASky Airlines (KP)** – activated direct access and PNR Sync on Travelport+
- **Corvus Airlines (7H)** – activated NAVS, type B sell, electronic ticketing on Travelport+
- **Himalaya Airlines (H9)** – implemented EMD-A first and second excess bag on Travelport+
- **Avianca (AV)** – implemented EMD-A carry-on baggage, firearms, PCR test alliance, Antigen test, Travel assistance long on Travelport+
- **Evelop Airlines (E9)** – implemented EMD-A excess baggage, sporting equipment, media equipment, televisions, meals, priority check-in, check-in
- **Air Cote Divoire (HF)** – implemented EMD-S misc

There is now a total of 438 Ancillaries available across 98 Airlines.
